Main Street Festival 2026 Rules & Regulations

APPLICATIONS:

- The Wellsville Area Chamber of Commerce reserves the right to refuse any vendor application and/or re-categorize vendor type.
- Spaces are assigned on a **first come, first serve basis**. Requests can and will be taken into consideration but may not be honored due to unforeseen circumstances. **Priority for Main Street spots will be given to vendors who have previously participated on the Main Street Festival.** Event space is limited and once the event is full, applications will not be accepted.
- Event Permit** - Vendors will receive an Event Permit when they receive their vendor space number. Vendors are to sign the permit and bring a copy with them to the event. Any vendor set-up that does not have an Event Permit, will be asked to leave by the police.
- Electricity is limited and there will be a \$25.00 fee if needed.
- Depending on product, you may need proof of insurance. Food vendors for example.
- Vendor tents, tables and products must fit in a 10x10 booth space unless you purchase additional space.
- Political or offensive products are not allowed - this is a family event.
- No refunds will be given.
- Once your application, payment and copy of your insurance (if required) are received and accepted you will receive an email confirmation.
- NOTE:** You will receive your vendor space number and map approximately 3 days prior to event.

SET UP / TEAR-DOWN:

- Use only Main Street for loading and unloading.
- Set up time is between 7:00am and 8:15am on Saturday July 18, 2026. No vehicles on street after 8:15am. No exceptions.
- You must unload at your assigned space and move your vehicle off Main Street before setting up your booth. Park in authorized parking lots legally.
- You must man your booth from 9:00am to 4:00pm. No early tear downs.
- Sales end at 4:00pm. You must tear down and vacate Main Street by 5:00pm.
- All garbage must be removed from booth space and disposed of properly.

EVENT:

- Children under 14 must have adult supervision.
- No rain dates.
- No dogs or smoking/vaping permitted.
- The Wellsville Area Chamber of Commerce and The Village of Wellsville are not responsible for any theft or damage.
- Failure to abide by our Rules & Regulations will result in the vendor not being allowed at future events.



Are you dying to have some fun? Would you kill for a night out? The Wellsville Development Corporation invites the community to its annual Murder Mystery Dinner Fundraiser on Thursday, March 5, 2026, from 6:00–8:30 PM at the Wellsville Country Club & Restaurant.

“The Murder Mystery Dinner is so much more than dinner and a show,” said Molly Cole, President of the Wellsville Development Corporation. “This interactive experience doesn’t take place on a stage—it unfolds right among the guests. Someone has died—maybe even more than one person—and it’s everyone’s job to solve the crime.”


